This implies that first appellate authority did not entertain the submitted RTI first appeal by the appellant which is a mockery of the provisions of right to information act 2005.

3- Most respected sir, right to information act 2005 was introduced by the government of India to promote transparency and accountability in the working of public authorities but there is doubt that this act will achieve its goal because there is rampant corruption in the government machinery and in no public information officer is providing information to information seekers.

4- The appellant sought following 5-point information from the public information officer as follows.

1- Please provide the inquiry report obtained from the team of inquiry instituted at the district level Sant Ravidas Nagar Bhadohi under the authority of Chief Medical Officer Bhadohi.

2- Please provide the information-If the report of inquiry obtained from the Chief Medical Officer Bhadohi was challenged by either of the parties before the senior rank authorities.

3- Please provide the details of the disciplinary action taken against Dr Pradeep Kumar Yadav by the department as told before the Uttar Pradesh Information Commission by the public information officer directorate.

4- Please provide the details of action taken against Dr Pradeep Kumar Yadav as well as chief medical superintendent of government hospital Sant Ravidas Nagar Bhadohi because both were found guilty of non-cooperating the team of inquiry.

Please take a glance at the second page of the attached PDF document.

5- Please provide the communications details exchanged with the Chief Medical Officer Prayagraj as well as wrongdoer private clinic Chhote Lal Bind hospital allowing private practise by Govt doctors in its private clinic against rule framed by the government and breaching the terms and condition of the licence provided by the office of Chief Medical Officer Prayagraj.

5-The Right to information act 2005 was introduced by the government of India to promote transparency and accountability in the working of the public authorities, but it is most unfortunate no public authority wants to provide the information to the information seekers. Since the corruption in the working of the public authorities is rampant, so they do not want transparency and accountability in their workings which is the root cause they are diluting the provisions of the right to information act 2005 by hatching conspiracy against the act.

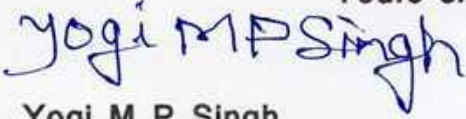

additional director in the directorate of medical and health whose representative Junior Assistant Sanjay Kumar told the commission as follows. 1- Dr Pradeep Kumar Yadav was found guilty prima facie in the matter of private practice so disciplinary action has been taken against said Doctor. 2- Additional director Mirzapur has been nominated as a subsequent inquiry officer in the matter. The inquiry is undergoing. 3- As the inquiry report will be obtained so action will be taken against the guilty.

This is a humble request of your applicant to you Hon'ble Sir that how can it be justified to withhold public services arbitrarily and promote anarchy, lawlessness, and chaos arbitrarily by making the mockery of law of land?
