Prayer- Public information officer did not provide the information
by not entertaining the RTI application and also First appellate
authority did not entertain appeal submitted by the appellant
illegally without considering the pros and cons of the result.

(1) Yogi M P Singh

Please act against the public information officer under section 20 of the right to information act 2005 and order disciplinary action against the working of the first appellate authority for withholding the information by not entertaining the first appeal submitted by the appellant.

Short submissions of the appellant are as follows.

1- From the following status of the submitted RTI application by the appellant, it is obvious that the appellant submitted the rti application on 2nd February 2025 which has not been entertained by the public information officer still.

2- From the following status of the submitted RTI appeal by the appellant, it is obvious that the appellant submitted the rti appeal on 20th March 2025 which has not been entertained by the First appellate authority still.

This implies that the First appellate authority took the provisions of the right to information act 2005 under teeth.

3 The Yogi government provided billions of rupees of land to Lions club @Rs.50 annually. This land belongs to the municipality Mirzapur City and they have issued notices to the Lions Club to vacate the land but instead of it the government of Yogi Adityanath Sir extended the lease again for 40 years. There are two types of evidence of corruption: the first is direct evidence and the second is the circumstantial evidence. Lease of land was given to Lions club to develop a garden for children of common people which was not followed so affiliation must be cancelled.

4-The following 5 points information have been sought by the appellant from public information officer.

1-Provide the copy of the lease extended by the government for thirty years.

2-Provide the details of public staff, communications exchanged which superseded the proposal of municipality Mirzapur city to cancel the lease as its terms and conditions were broken by the leaseholder.

3-Provide the reason as required under subsection 1 d of section 4 Right to Information Act 2005 of rejecting the legal and justified

proposal of the board of municipality Mirzapur city concerned with the wide public interest.

4-Provide fee details charged from the Lions club as lease of public land during starting of the lease and at present.

5-Provide the copy of the communication of Lions club or Lions school management on which the government took the decision to extend the lease.

5- The lease of the land of municipality was granted by the government of Uttar Pradesh by overlooking the request of the municipality board Mirzapur city which was illegal, unconstitutional and grossly unjustified. Honourable Sir, since the date lease of land was done forty years passed in 2010 but neither a garden for children of common people was developed nor opened for common children as stated by the municipality Mirzapur city in the aforementioned letter. Factual position is that Lions club is carrying out commercial activities in the land, not allowed to leaseholder, by taking concerned officers in good faith. Despite such irregularities which was reported to department of Urban Development, Government of Uttar Pradesh, Government of Uttar Pradesh extended the lease for next 30 years which will end in 2040 overlooking the fact that Municipality Mirzapur city is an autonomous body and encroached independent powers of municipality Mirzapur city.

6-It is a well-known fact that the matter raised by the appellant is concerning with the corruption in the working of the public authority and public information officer is running away from providing the information under Right to information act 2005 only showing that something is wrong in the working of the public authority invite the investigation by the police or appropriate investigation agency.

Most respected sir both public information officer and first appellate authority made the mockery of the provisions of right to information act 2005 so harsh steps must be taken under section 20 of RTI act 2005 against PIO and disciplinary action against FAA.
