The most surprising thing is that in the appeal, first appellate authority submitted a report of the public information officer through which public information officer denied information.

3-The appellant sought following information from the public information officer as follows.

1- Please provide the name and designation of the public staff who received this advisory sent by the home ministry to the government of Uttar Pradesh and thereafter it was sent to concerned through office of Chief Secretary and Home Department.

2- Please provide the name and designation of the police personnel who processed this advisory in the office of superintendent of police district Mirzapur.

3- Provide the list of police stations in which this advisory has been sent by the office of Superintendent of police district Mirzapur.

4- Please provide the list of reporting police outposts in which this advisory has been sent by the office of Superintendent of police district Mirzapur.

5-Right to reason is an indispensable part of the sound administrative system quoted by the apex court of India in its judgement. If no action has been taken by the office of Superintendent of police district Mirzapur on this advisory, then provide its reason to the information seeker.

4-Most respected sir the appellant sought information concerning the advisory as follows. Kumal, Joint Secretary to the Govt. of India, sent the following advisory to the state governments On 12th October 2015 On behalf of government of India ministry of home affairs as follows. This enquiry is being made to know the current status of the compliance by the concerned departments.

Reference is invited to this Ministry Advisories dated 10th May 2013 and 5th February 2014 regarding compulsory registration of FIR u/s 154 Cr P.C (copies enclosed).

Most respected Sir advisory is attached to this online rti appeal for kind perusal of the most respected sir in 6 pages.

5- It is obvious that the rti application which was rejected by the office of the superintendent of police was sent to the office of Chief Secretary Government of Uttar Pradesh by the appellant who transferred the rti application to the Department of home and Department of home transferred the rti application to the office of director General of police who again transferred the rti application to the superintendent of police Mirzapur. This implies that advisory sent by the home ministry is the part of dealing of the district police Mirzapur.

6- Now it is obligatory duty of the PIO to tell the applicant how it reach to the police stations and police outposts which is required under the law? If not reached he must also provide the reason of it. - 7- Think about the sensitivity of the public staff to the rights of women, the advisory concerning the compulsory registration of first information report in case of women, is not available in the records of office of superintendent of police, disclosed by public information officer in the office of Superintendent of police Mirzapur.
- 8- According to PIO, Please be informed in your online appeal application form SPMZR/A/2025/60020 dated 12.04.2025 regarding providing information under the Right to Information Act-2005, an advisory was sent by the Home Ministry of the Government of India to the Chief Secretary of all the States and Union Territories on 12 October 2015 regarding the mandatory registration of First Information Report under Section 154 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in relation to which the applicant had sought information regarding receipt of the said advisory in district-Mirzapur.

In this regard, you are to be informed that since the advisory was issued 10 years ago, the said advisory is not found in the records of the Police Office, District Mirzapur.

9-Most respected sir this advisory of the home ministry is addressed to the chief secretary of the state governments and Union territories administration. If it is true that this advisory of year 2015 has not reached the office of Superintendent of Police Mirzapur which is a blunder on the part of Office of Chief Secretary and concerned staff whoever dealt with this advisory.

10-This implies that the office of Chief Secretary Government of Uttar Pradesh took under teeth by sitting on the advisory of the home ministry which was to be forwarded to the home ministry of the state government and then office of Director General of police and onwards to the subordinates. The motive of this

appeal is only to ensure that the advisory of the home ministry is really not reached to the office of senior superintendent of police district Mirzapur. The advisory is attached to this appeal.

This is a humble request of your appellant to you Hon'ble Sir that how can it be justified to withhold public services arbitrarily and promote anarchy, lawlessness, and chaos arbitrarily by making the mockery of law of land? There is need of the hour to take harsh steps against the wrongdoer to win the confidence of citizenry and strengthen the democratic values for healthy and prosperous democracy. For this, your appellant shall ever pray for you, Hon'ble Sir.
