Appellant Shri Yogi M.P. Singh has sought information through online application number-LKDPA/R/2025/60280 dated-28.04.2025 submitted under Section-6(1) of the Right to Information Act-2005. The received online application form has been transferred to the concerned Public Information Officer. As per rules, on not receiving the information within the prescribed period/being dissatisfied with the information, the applicant filed an online first appeal application on date-10.05.2025, in

continuation of which the hearing of the first appeal received online was fixed on date- 28.05.2025 and information was sent to the appellant for hearing. The appellant was absent on the scheduled date of hearing. The concerned Public Information Officer/his representative appeared. During the hearing, it was found from the scrutiny of the file that no documentary evidence of sending information to the appellant is available in the file.

Therefore, it is ordered that Shri Hemchandra Tiwari, Consolidation Officer / J.S.A., L.V.P., should clearly provide the information to be provided as per rules to the appellant within 15 days of passing of this order in relation to the online application of the applicant.

Accordingly, the online first appeal in question is disposed of.

4- Most respected sir, please take a glance of the sought information by the appellant.

1- Please provide the name and designation with posting details of the competent officer who has set up the committee to look into the irregularities in committing execution of registry and the allotment of the plots.

2- Please provide the name and designation of the members of the committee who were appointed by the competent authority as well as their posting details.

3- Please provide the span of time given to the committee to complete the enquiry into the matter of irregularity, if not given then please provide the maximum time whatever will be given to the committee to complete the inquiry. It is quite obvious that two years and four months have passed but the committee could not complete the inquiry.

4- For five years Lucknow development authority has been seeking documents from the allottees of the plots, Please provide the reason for not taking any action against them as right to reason is the indispensable part of the sound administrative system quoted by the apex court of India in its various judgments.

5-Dinesh Pratap Singh submitted a document of 20 pages before a committee set up for looking for anomalies in allocation plots by L.D.A. Details are as follows.

7-L.D.A. may provide the copy of the order passed by the competent court deciding the title suit of the Anuradha Singh in the compliance of the High court order in the Writ Petition Number 135 HC Year 2006.

8-L.D.A. may provide the detail of the posting of the staff executing the registry of impugned plots to allottees with designation and name so that accountability may be fixed.

9-Detail of the committee setup to check the irregularities including name, designation and posting details of its members which may include date of joining the department.

5- Most respected Sir, please take a glance at the first page of the attached PDF document to this online RTI second appeal which is the communication dated 6th August 2021 of the property officer of Lucknow development authority in respect of representation submitted by the information seeker. LDA is seeking documents from the allottees in the matter as well as a committee has been set up by the competent authority of the Lucknow development authority to make inquiry into the matter of irregularities in executing registry of the impugned land as well as irregularities in the allocation of the plots by Lucknow development authority.

Whether the letter of nomination of the committee members and letter of issue of the formation of committee are not part of the working of the Lucknow Development Authority as required under the law. Whether such records are not maintained by the Lucknow Development Authority?

7- If the committee has been formed by the public authority, then who has formed this committee? Whether the report submitted by the property officer on the Jansunwai Portal is not part of the document of the Lucknow Development Authority?

8- It is noticeable that Lucknow development authority in its various reports submitted on the public grievance portal and Jansunwai Portal of the government of India that a committee has been formed to look into the irregularities in the plot allocation and registry of the plots in the matter concerned.

9- This is a humble request to the most respected Sir, please direct the public information officer not to escape from providing information on the flimsy and false ground to the information seeker concerning the rampant corruption in the working of the Lucknow Development Authority. Such a cryptic approach only promotes corruption in the working of the public authority which must be curbed by the accountable staff of the department.

This is a humble request of your appellant to you Hon'ble Sir that how can it be justified to withhold public services arbitrarily and promote anarchy, lawlessness, and chaos arbitrarily by making the mockery of law of land? There is need of the hour to take harsh steps against the wrongdoer to win the confidence of citizenry and strengthen the democratic values for healthy and prosperous democracy.
