Subject- Regarding the compliance of the order of the most respected presiding officer Shri R K Vishukarma/chief information commissioner, Uttar Pradesh of Honourable court S-1.

Short submissions of the appellant are as follows.

1-Most respected presiding officer of Honourable court S-1 passed the following order on 10th June 2025 as follows.

In the hearing today, the representative present on behalf of the Public Information Officer, Mr. Jitendra Kumar, Inspector, Kotwali Police Station Katra, Mirzapur District, presented the written statement dated 09.06.2025 of the Public Information Officer / Additional Superintendent of Police, City District Mirzapur addressed to the Commission, which was placed on the file. Through the said letter, the updated report of the said investigation was compiled and presented by the respondent in the hearing today, which was observed by the Commission.

The Commission noted that the applicant's written statement/objection letter dated 09.06.2025 is attached to the file, which was received by the Commission through e-mail, which was perused by the Commission. During the hearing today, the Commission provided a copy of the applicant's said statement/objection letter to the respondent party.

Order

In the above order, Shri Jitendra Kumar, Inspector, Police Station Kotwali Katra, Mirzapur is directed to inform the appellant about the progress report of the case and present the report of the action taken before the Commission on the next hearing date. Also, the respondent is directed to properly dispose of the applicant's said allegation and provide revised information and ensure that the Commission is also informed about it.

2- Respected senior superintendent of police Mirzapur, It is 11th July 2025 and the concerned investigation officer has not disposed of the representation of the

applicant as directed by the most respected chief information commissioner of Uttar Pradesh. Whether the investigation officer will communicate the disposal of representation in compliance with the direction of the most respected commission on the date of hearing fixed i.e. on 16th July 2025.

3-Respected senior superintendent of police Mirzapur, It is not only legal right but also constitutional right of the appellant to submit the objection on the report of redress of the representation of the appellant by the investigation officer if any Lacunae found before the competent authority.

4-Respected senior superintendent of police Mirzapur, Gravity of the matter can easily be considered from the fact that there are fraudulent transactions of Rs.350,000,000 by misusing the permanent account number of the appellant. FIR No. 291/23, Section 420 IPC and 66C and 66D IT Act, Police Station Katra, District Mirzapur, plaintiff M.P. Singh,

This matter is languishing because of procrastination of concerned police personnel.

5-Respected senior superintendent of police Mirzapur, There are nearly 200 companies who made fraudulent transactions by misusing the PAN of the appellant and details of these delinquents are available in the tax information summary. The details of fraudulent transactions of Rs.350,000,000 are also available in the tax information summary. Still Investigation officers are saying that they are collecting the evidence in the matter. It is noticeable that this investigation is being monitored by the most respected chief information commissioner of the government of Uttar Pradesh so the standard of investigation can be easily understood. Whether the Mirzapur Police do not know how to deal with the matter being processed under the monitoring of constitutional functionaries?

This is a humble request of the appellant to the respected senior superintendent of police Mirzapur to take action in the matter in accordance with the law. Vide attached order of the most respected presiding officer.

4- It was an obligatory duty of the concerned public information officers to abide by the order passed by the most respected constitutional functionary in letters and spirit but they overlooked it.

This is a humble request of the appellant to the most respected sir to protect the dignity of the office by taking appropriate action against the guilty who took the order passed by the most respected commission under their teeth.
