

This representation concerns my pending First Appeal filed before your esteemed office against the unsatisfactory reply to my Right to Information (RTI) application.

Grounds for Urgent Intervention

I appeal to your office to urgently adjudicate the pending First Appeal based on the following facts:

- Denial of Administrative Records:** My RTI application (Points 1, 2, 3, and 5) sought administrative details (e.g., name/designation of receiving staff, file notings, existing Action Taken Reports, etc.) which are existing records. The PIO's reply denied all these points solely stating that the investigation is "in progress." This is a legally unsound refusal, as the PIO is mandated to provide **all available information** and cannot refuse existing administrative records based on an ongoing inquiry.
- Statutory Violation:** The PIO's reply also directed me to "again apply for RTI" after the investigation. This evasive response attempts to shift the burden back onto the applicant and violates the core principle of the RTI Act by delaying the provision of information already on file.
- Importance of Underlying Matter:** The information sought relates to compliance with a direction from the **Uttar Pradesh Human Rights Commission**. The failure to provide basic details about the handling of this important communication reflects poorly on the administrative accountability of the office.

Prayer

I humbly request you, as the First Appellate Authority, to:

- Expedite the Decision** on my pending First Appeal and issue an order immediately.
- Direct the PIO** to furnish the requested administrative information (Points 1, 2, 3, and 5) within **7 days**, as this information is readily available on the file.
- Ensure accountability for the delayed and non-compliant response issued by the PIO's office.

I trust that your intervention will uphold the letter and spirit of the RTI Act, 2005.
