**SUBJECT: PRAYER FOR IMPOSITION OF PENALTY UNDER SECTION 20(1) AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER SECTION 20(2) OF THE RTI ACT, 2005.****Most Respected Madam,**

The Appellant most humbly submits the following grounds for the imposition of penalty against the PIO (CMO Mirzapur):

- Violation of Section 6(2):** The PIO, vide communication dated 01/02/2025, illegally asked the Appellant to provide "justification" and "public interest" for the RTI request. This is a direct violation of **Section 6(2)** of the RTI Act, which states that an applicant shall NOT be required to give any reason for requesting information.
- Malafide Denial under Section 8(1)(d):** The PIO has sought protection under "Commercial Confidence" to hide public expenditure data regarding TB medicines and government diagnostic policies. These are public records and do not involve trade secrets. This is a **malafide (bad faith) attempt** to obstruct the transparency of public health funds.
- Non-Compliance with Commission's Directions:** Despite the Commission's previous observations/orders, the PIO has failed to provide point-wise, clear information and continues to use meritless exemptions to delay the matter.
- Harassment of the Appellant:** The Appellant has been forced to pursue this second appeal for over a year due to the PIO's stubborn refusal to disclose even basic government orders and expenditure figures.

**PRAYER**

In light of the above, it is most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Commission may be pleased to:

- **Impose a penalty of ₹25,000/-** on the PIO, CMO Mirzapur, under **Section 20(1)** of the RTI Act for willfully and without reasonable cause denying the information.
- **Recommend Disciplinary Action** against the PIO under **Section 20(2)** for repeated obstruction of the Act.
- **Direct the PIO** to provide all information on oath within 48 hours.

**Respected Madam,**

With reference to the ongoing second appeal (**Registration No: A-20241102153**) listed for hearing on **24/12/2025**, the Appellant (Yogi M.P. Singh) wishes to submit the following points for the Hon'ble Commission's kind consideration:

1. Illegal Denial under Section 8(1)(d):

The Public Information Officer (PIO/CMO Mirzapur) has denied information regarding employee postings by classifying them as "Commercial Confidence" or "Trade Secrets." This is a gross misinterpretation of the law. Postings, tenures, and CUG numbers of public servants are administrative records and mandatory public disclosures under Section 4(1)(b) of the RTI Act. There is no "competitive position of a third party" involved in the transfer of government staff.

2. Violation of Section 6(2) of the RTI Act:

The PIO, through communication dated 01.02.2025, illegally demanded to know the "justification" and "public interest" behind my request. I wish to remind the Commission that Section 6(2) explicitly states: "An applicant making a request for information shall not be required to give any reason for requesting the information."

3. Attempt to Shield Administrative Malpractice:

By withholding the duration of stay for Class I, II, III, and IV employees, the PIO is attempting to conceal violations of the State Government's Transfer Policy. Long-

term postings at the same location often become breeding grounds for corruption, and the RTI Act was specifically enacted to expose such irregularities.

#### 4. Prayer for Penalty:

The PIO has not only failed to provide information but has also knowingly provided misleading and legally unsustainable reasons for denial. I humbly request the Hon'ble Commission to:

- Direct the PIO to provide the information immediately in a point-wise format.
- Initiate penalty proceedings against the PIO under **Section 20(1)** of the RTI Act (₹250 per day) for willful obstruction of information.
- Recommend disciplinary action under **Section 20(2)** for the PIO's persistent disregard for the Act's provisions.

Transparency is the hallmark of democracy. If administrative transfers are treated as "trade secrets," the very soul of the RTI Act 2005 is compromised.
