Subject: First Appeal against the "Deemed Refusal" and total inaction of the PIO (Tehsildar Sadar) regarding RTI Registration Number: DMOMR/R/2025/60361. 1. DETAILS OF THE INFORMATION SOUGHT: The appellant sought 7 specific points regarding government flood relief assistance in Village Panchayat: Nibi Gaharwar, Block: Chhanbey, Tehsil: Mirzapur Sadar. This included lists of beneficiaries, certified copies of payment records, and the names of public staff involved. 5. GROUNDS FOR APPEAL: Violation of Section 7(1): The PIO failed to provide any response, rejection, or intimation within the mandatory 30-day period which expired on 07/01/2026. Deemed Refusal: As per Section 7(2) of the RTI Act, 2005, the failure to provide a decision within the prescribed time is treated as a "Deemed Refusal." Public Interest: The information concerns the distribution of government funds and relief for disaster victims (flood). Transparency in this matter is a fundamental requirement of the RTI Act. 6. PRAYER / RELIEF SOUGHT: The Appellant most humbly prays that the FAA may be pleased to: Direct the PIO to provide complete, point-wise, and certified information as requested in the original application immediately. Invoke Section 7(6): Since the PIO failed to comply with the time limits, all information, including the "Certified Copies of	

Beneficiaries List" (Point 4) and "Govt Orders" (Point 5), must now be provided FREE OF COST. Inquiry: Initiate an inquiry into why the PIO (Tehsildar Sadar) did not entertain a legitimate RTI request involving flood relief. Personal Hearing: The appellant requests a personal hearing as per the principles of natural justice. 7. DECLARATION: I hereby declare that the particulars given above are true to the best of my knowledge and belief. No similar appeal has been filed before any other authority or court.
