5. Grounds for Second Appeal:

1. **Jurisdictional Misrepresentation:** The PIO's claim that a case involving **Sections 66C and 66D of the IT Act** "does not concern cyber crime" is legally untenable and factually incorrect.
2. **Incomplete/Misleading Information:** On Point 1, the PIO provided only the minimum rank (Inspector), intentionally withholding the identity of the **Gazetted Supervisory Officers** required for a ₹50 Crore scam investigation.
3. **Willful Obstruction:** By refusing to provide statistics (Points 3 & 4) and training data (Point 2) instead of transferring the request under **Section 6(3)**, the PIO has acted in bad faith.
4. **FAA Negligence:** The First Appellate Authority failed to provide a speaking order or rectify the PIO's contradictory stand within the statutory period.

6. Prayers / Relief Sought:

1. Direct the PIO to provide point-wise, specific information as requested in the "Corrected" version of the application.



2. **Impose Penalty:** Invoke **Section 20(1)** to impose a penalty of ₹250 per day on the PIO for providing false and misleading information.
3. **Disciplinary Action:** Recommend proceedings against the PIO under **Section 20(2)** for persistent obstruction of the Right to Information.
