Any further generic reply will be treated as an admission of professional misconduct and a deliberate attempt to shield corrupt practices at the local enrolment centers. I require a **Speaking Order** detailing the specific rule that invalidates this state-approved document.

### Grievance Description:

I am reporting a deliberate attempt to stall the Aadhaar enrollment of my son, Narayan Pratap Singh (Born 11-09-2016). Despite following every legal rule, the system is being manipulated to create a deadlock, effectively forcing a path toward "backdoor income".

### Evidence of Compliance:

1- I possess a valid Birth Certificate (Reg No B-2023: 9-58804-009512) issued by PHC Vijaypur under the RBD Act 1969.

2- The Directorate of Medical and Health Services, UP, in Letter 24F/VS/IGRS-331/2025, has officially confirmed the document is authentic.

3- The Health Department specifically notes that the Aadhaar Office is the sole entity demanding an SDM order for a document that is already digitally verified and state-approved.

### Nature of Complaint:

The local Revenue Department (SDM Sadar, Mirzapur) and Aadhaar facilitation centers are providing non-responsive, generic reports. This refusal to provide a specific technical rejection reason for a state-verified document is a violation of the Aadhaar Act and Article 51A of the

**Constitution.** I have submitted over half a dozen representations with zero results, suggesting a manufactured complexity to solicit bribes.

**Demand:**

UIDAI must provide a categorical "Speaking Order" stating exactly which technical rule invalidates a certificate approved by the Office of the DG Health, UP. If no such rule exists, UIDAI must issue a direct instruction to the Lucknow Regional Office to override local stalling and complete this enrolment immediately.

The arbitrary and cryptic reply Of the public authorities is also an ingredient to the corruption. Why is the Department of Unique identification authority of India is not justifying: How Date of birth registration Done by the Department of Health Is not admissible for making aadhaar? To take bribe is one of characteristics of corrupts.

Grievance Description: I am writing to report a systemic issue regarding the enrollment of my son, Narayan Pratap Singh (Born: 11-09-2016). I possess a valid, digitally verifiable Birth Certificate issued by the Department of Medical and Health, Uttar Pradesh (PHC Vijaypur) on 24-03-2023.

Despite the document being authentic and issued by the State Government, the Aadhaar Enrollment Center/UIDAI system is refusing to accept it.

I request UIDAI to clarify the following:

Technical Reason for Rejection: If the certificate is rejected because of the 9-year delay, please state if a Revenue Department Verification Order (Section 13(3) RBD Act) is specifically required.

Verification Status: Does the certificate (Reg No: B-2023: 9-58804-009512) appear as "Verified" in the UIDAI backend database?

Instruction to Local Authorities: The local Revenue Department (SDM Sadar, Mirzapur) is providing generic replies and stalling the verification process. A formal rejection reason from UIDAI is required to force administrative action.

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Rating Remarks

The disposal of this grievance is a textbook example of administrative apathy and deliberate obfuscation. Instead of investigating why a valid, digitally verifiable Birth Certificate issued by the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh is being rejected by the Aadhaar ecosystem, the Regional Office provided a generic link to a PDF and told me to scan the QR code. This is a redundant instruction that ignores the complainant's technical expertise and the specific facts provided. The failure to provide a specific reason for rejection - despite the certificate being authentic - suggests either a massive technical failure in UIDAI's backend synchronization or a deliberate attempt to sustain a complex system where local corrupt functionaries thrive on "backdoor" solutions. Closing a grievance without ensuring the service is actually rendered is a mockery of the Digital India mission. I reject this resolution.

Appeal Text

Subject: Appeal against unsatisfactory Disposal of Grievance UIDAI-E-2026-0002196. Systemic Evasion and Failure to Address Technical Rejection of Valid Birth Certificate. I am filing this appeal because the resolution provided by RO Lucknow (Deputy Director Vipin Verma) is evasive and fails to address the core technical issue. The grievance regarding the enrollment of Narayan Pratap Singh (Born 11-09-2016) was closed with a

generic instruction to scan the QR code, which I have already done. The QR code on Birth Certificate (Reg No B-2023: 9-58804-009512) is fully functional and verifies the document on the UP Government portal. However, the Aadhaar Enrollment System continues to reject this document. The RO Lucknow has failed to answer the specific technical queries raised: 1- Database Sync Issue: Is this specific registration number indexed in the UIDAI backend "In-built Validation" list? If a document is digitally verifiable but rejected by the software, it indicates a failure of UIDAI to sync with the State Birth Registry. 2- Late Registration Policy: Does UIDAI require a Section 13(3) RBD Act (Magistrate Order) for certificates issued after a 9-year delay, even if they are digitally signed? The RO avoided this legal clarification. 3-Abuse of Process: By providing a template reply, the department is shielding local operators who use technical "errors" as a pretext to solicit bribes or harass citizens. This lack of transparency is a direct violation of the principles of the Aadhaar Act and Article 51A of the Constitution. I demand that this case be reopened. I request a Speaking Order from the Nodal Officer explaining exactly why the UIDAI software rejects a valid, state-issued QR-coded document. If the document is valid, UIDAI must issue a direct instruction to the Mirzapur District Administration / SDM Sadar to facilitate this enrolment without further delay.
