Respected Hon'ble State Information Commissioner,

I, Naresh Kumar Jaiswal, am the Appellant in the above-mentioned Second Appeal. I am submitting this written representation to ensure it is part of the permanent record, as oral statements lack the weight required to fix administrative accountability.

1. Failure to Provide Specific Information: The PIO and FAA have failed to provide the **Forwarding Letter** addressed to the Secretary, UPHRC, as requested in Point 2 of my RTI. Instead, they provided an internal "Janch Akhya" (Inquiry Report) dated 19/10/2025, which is an internal communication and not the official outward dispatch requested.

2. Suppression of Records: The Public Authority has willfully withheld the **Dispatch/Patrank Number** and **Certified Copies of File Notings**, which were explicitly sought to track the handling of the UPHRC order dated 27/08/2025.

3. Statutory Delay: The RTI application was filed on **08/09/2025**, but the PIO's reply was only issued on **14/10/2025**, exceeding the 30-day statutory limit mandated by the RTI Act.

4. Compliance with Supreme Court Guidelines: As per the guidelines of the **Hon'ble Supreme Court of India**, it is mandatory for public authorities and commissions to utilize registered email addresses for all communications to save time and public money. I wish to record that I have not been receiving consistent email updates from the department/commission and request that all future correspondence be sent to nareshkumarjaiswal8@gmail.com.

Prayer: I humbly pray that the Hon'ble Commission:

- Direct the PIO to provide the specific **Forwarding Letter with Dispatch Details** and **Certified File Notings**.
- Impose a penalty on the PIO under **Section 20(1)** for the delay and for providing a misleading/mismatched response.
