Archana Dubey vs. Superintendent of Police, Mirzapur OBJECTION AGAINST THE INCOMPLETE & BIASED INVESTIGATION REPORT DATED 18.02.2026 Most Respectfully Showeth: The Applicant/Complainant begs to submit this objection against the report submitted by CO City, Mirzapur, which was prepared following the directions of this Hon'ble Commission. The report is a gross miscarriage of justice due to the following reasons: 1. Failure to Investigate the Incident of 24.10.2025 The CO report focuses largely on a previous incident from September 2025 and an existing property dispute. It completely overlooks the specific criminal act of October 24, 2025, where the accused broke the locks of the applicant's residence and committed a daylight robbery of jewelry worth ₹8 lakh and household goods. The report fails to document the physical state of the "broken locks" or the illegal dispossession of the applicant. 2. Suppression of Primary Digital Evidence (CCTV DVR) The applicant explicitly informed the authorities that the entire robbery and house-grabbing incident was captured on CCTV. The DVR containing this evidence is in the illegal possession of the accused, Vikas Dubey. The CO's investigation is intentionally silent on why this DVR was not seized or examined, which constitutes a deliberate attempt to shield the offenders. 3. Reliance on Hearsay and Character Assassination The Inquiry Officer dismissed the theft of ₹8 lakh by relying on the statement of the accused, Savitri Devi, who claimed the applicant "brought nothing" in dowry. A victim's financial background is irrelevant to the commission of a cognizable offense; the CO has substituted legal investigation with the biased narrative of the perpetrators. 4. Violation of UPSHRC Directions This Commission directed the SP Mirzapur to act by "associating the complainant". However, the resulting report merely validates the version of the accused while the applicant and her 9-year-old child remain homeless and under constant threat. PRAYER It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Commission may be pleased to: Reject the biased investigation report dated 18.02.2026 submitted by the Mirzapur Police. Direct the SP, Mirzapur, to immediately recover the CCTV DVR from the accused's possession. Order a Fresh Inquiry by a senior officer (IPS rank) from outside the Mirzapur district to ensure an impartial probe into the theft and illegal possession. Direct the local police to ensure the applicant's safety and possession of her legally partitioned residence. ****Subject: **** Objection Against Biased Investigation Report by CO City Mirzapur Regarding Daylight Robbery and House Grabbing on 24/10/2025

****Dear Hon'ble Sir,****

I am Archana Devi, and I wish to bring to your attention the bias and misconduct demonstrated by the Circle Officer (CO) City, Mirzapur, in his investigation report dated 18.02.2026 concerning the robbery and house-grabbing incident that occurred on 24/10/2025. Below are the key points of my objection:

1. **Suppression of Digital Evidence: **

- The report neglects the CCTV evidence capturing the robbery. This video is currently in the possession of the accused, Vikas Dubey. The failure to obtain this evidence demonstrates an abuse of power intended to protect the perpetrators.

2. **Character Assassination Instead of Investigation: **

- The CO relied on statements from the accused, Savitri Devi, claiming I come from a "poor family" and "brought nothing" as dowry. Instead of pursuing evidence of the theft, the CO judged my economic status from 14 years ago, reflecting clear bias.

3. **Misclassification of the Offence: **

- The CO has mischaracterised the robbery and house trespass as a "Family Property Dispute" to avoid filing an FIR. This undermines the severity of the crime and disregards my situation, as my 9-year-old child and I have been left homeless.

4. **Ignoring Existing Settlements: **

- The CO suggests I seek court resolution, disregarding notarised settlement agreements from

2014 and 2025 that document my half-share of the property. The police are failing to enforce these legal agreements.

****Prayer: ****

I kindly request your Hon'ble Office to:

- Reject the biased report of CO City Mirzapur dated 18.02.2026.
- Order a fresh inquiry by an officer from another district or a senior IPS officer to ensure impartiality.
- Direct the recovery of the CCTV DVR and the stolen jewellery worth ₹8 lakh.
- Ensure the restoration of my possession of the partitioned house in Ghurahu Patti.

****Sir,****

I, ****Archana Devi****, wife of ****Amit Kumar Dubey****, wish to bring to your immediate attention a situation of extreme physical hardship and legal injustice. I am currently ****7 months pregnant**** and have been rendered ****homeless**** due to the criminal acts of the accused and the failure of the local police to protect my possession.

1. Demand for Restoration of Status Quo

- **Incident Details:**

On ****October 24, 2025****, the offenders (Vikas Dubey, Savitri Devi, and others) committed a daylight robbery by breaking the locks of my residence at Ghode शहीद, Ghuru Patti. They replaced my locks with theirs, effectively "grabbing" my legally partitioned portion of the house.

- **Legal Basis:**

Under the principles of natural justice and criminal procedure, the police are duty-bound to restore the condition that existed prior to the crime.

- **Documentary Proof:**

My right to the property is established by the Notarized Settlement (Sulahnama) of **2014 and 2025**, which the Circle Officer has conveniently ignored in his report.

2. Humanitarian Crisis: Pregnancy and Child

- I am in the **third trimester** of my pregnancy and am facing severe medical and psychological distress due to being driven out of my home.

- My **9-year-old daughter** has been unable to attend school due to constant death threats issued by the offenders and their associate, **Tinku Tiwari**.

- Living in a rented room while my own house is illegally occupied by those who assaulted me is a violation of my basic Human Rights.

3. Failure to Secure Evidence (CCTV DVR)

- The entire act of house-breaking was captured on **CCTV**, yet the local police have colluded with the offenders by failing to seize the **DVR**. This suppression of evidence is the primary reason the status quo has not been restored.

PRAYER

In view of my advanced pregnancy and the ongoing atrocities, I request you to:

1. Direct **P.S. Kotwali City** to remove the illegal locks placed by the offenders and restore my possession of my partitioned portion of the house immediately.

2. Seize the **CCTV DVR** from the possession of Vikas Dubey to verify the "Date of Crime" and the forced entry.

3. Ensure the recovery of the stolen jewelry worth **₹8 lakh** and essential household items (Fridge, TV, Washing Machine) that were taken during the robbery.

Your failure to act will be viewed as a direct violation of the safety of a pregnant woman and a minor child, as already reported to the ****Chief Minister’s Office**** and the ****State Human Rights Commission****.
