WRITTEN REPRESENTATION ON BEHALF OF THE APPELLANT FOR NON-COMPLIANCE OF THE COMMISSION'S ORDER BY THE RESPONDENT

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

- That the Appellant filed an online RTI application under Section 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, on **10/11/2025** bearing Registration No: **DIRLB/R/2025/60405** before the Respondent, seeking 5 specific points of information regarding public grievances and official leave records.

- That due to total inaction and a "deemed refusal" by the Public Information Officer (PIO) within the mandatory 30-day period, the appellant preferred a first appeal under Section 19(1) on **13/01/2026** (Registration No: DIRLB/A/2026/60010). However, no relief or information was provided by the First Appellate Authority.

- That, subsequently, the Appellant approached this Hon'ble Commission by filing a Second Appeal on **04/03/2026**.

- That this Hon'ble Commission was pleased to pass an interim order on **08/05/2026**, explicitly directing the Respondent/PIO to complete the necessary actions, provide the requested information, and submit a compliance report/written statement at least two days prior to the scheduled hearing on **18/05/2026**.

- That despite clear and categorical directions from this Hon'ble Commission, the Respondent/PIO has wilfully failed, neglected, and refused to comply with the order dated **08/05/2026**. No information has

been supplied to the appellant till date, nor has any written action report been uploaded by the PIO within the stipulated time.

- That the requested information involves critical public interest regarding public servants facing criminal charges who are allegedly drawing paid leave to seek bail. The deliberate silence and non-compliance by the PIO strongly indicate a wilful intent to shield irregularities and obstruct transparency.

PRAYER

In view of the blatant non-compliance and disregard for the law shown by the respondent/PIO, the appellant most respectfully prays that this honourable commission may be pleased to:

- Take strict note of the non-compliance of the commission's order dated 08/05/2026 by the respondent/PIO.

- Direct the Respondent/PIO to immediately provide point-wise, complete, and certified copies of all 5 requested points of information to the Appellant **free of cost**, as mandated under Section 7(6) of the RTI Act.
 - Initiate penal proceedings against the erring PIO under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, for deliberately obstructing the flow of information and violating statutory timelines.

- Recommend disciplinary action against the PIO under Section 20(2) of the RTI Act for persistent non-cooperation and defying the orders of this Hon'ble Commission.

Pass any other order(s) which this Hon'ble Commission deems fit and proper in the interest of justice and administrative accountability.
