SUBJECT: Written Representation on behalf of the Appellant regarding the absolute non-compliance and failure of the Respondent (PIO) to deliver the mandated revised information/report within the timeline prescribed by the Hon'ble Commission's order dated 14/05/2026.

Respected Sir,

The Appellant most humbly and respectfully submits the following facts for the kind consideration of this Hon'ble Commission:

1. Explicit Judicial Directive of the Hon'ble Commission:

That during the previous hearing on **14/05/2026**, this Hon'ble Commission was pleased to pass a strict directive ordering the Respondent (Tehsildar, Tehsil-Sadar, Mirzapur) to appropriately dispose of the Appellant's formal Written Objection dated 14/05/2026. The Respondent was explicitly mandated to

present a **revised information report compiled in a clean tabular format** on the next date of hearing.

2. **Wilful Defiance of Prescribed Deadlines:**

That via Notice No. 202606S01N200410 dated 09/06/2026, the Hon'ble Commission explicitly directed the Respondent to upload their written statement/action-taken report in PDF format onto the departmental portal or email it to hearingcourts1.upic@up.gov.in **at least two days prior** to the scheduled hearing date (22/06/2026). However, as of today, **21/06/2026** (the eve of the hearing), the Respondent has completely failed to provide any such revised information or report to either the Appellant or the Commission's portal.

3. **Habitual Suppression of Information and Evasion:**

That the Respondent has exhibited a continuous pattern of misleading this Hon'ble Commission. In past cycles, the PIO resorted to tactical delays—either sharing deceptive, unverified documents on WhatsApp less than 24 hours prior to a hearing, or deploying backdated compliance claims (as exposed by digital metadata timestamps). By failing to upload anything two days prior to this hearing, the Respondent has once again intentionally choked the flow of information to prevent the Appellant from examining it.

4. **Contempt of Statutory Warnings:**

That this Hon'ble Commission, in its order dated 14/05/2026, had laid down a severe warning stating that any failure to resolve the objections would result in the immediate issuance of a **Show-Cause Notice** against the official. The total silence and absolute non-compliance by the Respondent prove a gross disregard for both the Right to Information Act, 2005, and the statutory authority of this Commission.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

In light of the documented administrative negligence, continuous evasion, and open defiance of judicial mandates by the Respondent, the Appellant most humbly prays that this Hon'ble Commission may be pleased to order:

1. **Imposition of Penalty under Section 20(1):** That a maximum statutory penalty of **₹25,000/- (Twenty-Five Thousand Rupees)** be imposed on the Public Information Officer (PIO) for deliberately obstructing, delaying, and withholding information without any reasonable cause.
2. **Issuance of Show-Cause Notice:** That a formal Show-Cause Notice be issued immediately against the Respondent as explicitly warned in the previous order, and departmental disciplinary actions be formally recommended.
3. **Mandatory Point-Wise Disclosure:** That the Respondent be stringently directed to provide specific, point-wise, and legible answers to the original RTI application—specifically identifying the officials who wrongly labeled a revenue dispute as a "police matter" (**Points 1, 2, & 4**), and detailing the action taken against the negligent village Lekhpal (**Point 3**)—strictly through official

registered post or the registered email address (yogimpsingh@gmail.com) in accordance with higher judicial guidelines.
