Archana Dubey Versus Respondent: The Superintendent of Police, Mirzapur REJOINDER AND FORMAL LEGAL OBJECTION TO THE BIASED, DEFECTIVE INVESTIGATION REPORT DATED 18/02/2026 SUBMITTED BY THE LOCAL POLICE MOST RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH: 1. Total Failure to Address the Prime Criminal Acts of 24/10/2025 The complainant states that on 24/10/2025, the named accused persons (Vikas Kumar Dubey, Divya Devi, Savitri Devi, and their criminal associates) executed a planned daylight robbery and house trespass. The perpetrators broke the physical locks of her residence at Ghode Shahid, Ghurahu Patti, Police Station City Kotwali, Mirzapur. During this criminal trespass, the offenders looted gold jewelry valued at approximately ₹8 Lakh and stole essential household items, including a washing machine, refrigerator, television, cooler, and food items. The investigation report dated 18/02/2026, compiled by Circle Officer (CO) City, Vivek Jawla, completely fails to address the physical evidence of the broken locks or the forced entry. Instead, the local police have mechanically labeled this severe cognizable offense as a "family property dispute" to avoid their statutory obligation to register a First Information Report (FIR) under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS). 2. Active Suppression of Crucial Digital Evidence (CCTV DVR) The local police report maintains a deliberate silence regarding the digital security infrastructure at the site of the crime. The complainant has repeatedly informed the investigating authorities that the private CCTV security system—installed and maintained by her husband—captured the entire lock-breaking, theft, and subsequent physical assault. The physical CCTV DVR is currently held under illegal custody by the accused individuals. The deliberate refusal of the local police to seize this critical digital evidence, despite possessing direct purchase and repair receipts proving the complainant's ownership, points to criminal suppression of evidence to shield the influential offenders. 3. Extreme Institutional Bias and Character Assassination in Evidence Review The Inquiry Officer has abandoned standard forensic procedures, relying entirely on the self-serving, unverified verbal statements of the accused party to dismiss the theft. The report adopts the verbatim claim of the accused, Savitri Devi, who alleged that the complainant "brought nothing" in her dowry, using this malicious statement to summarily dismiss the robbery of ₹8 Lakh in jewelry. A police inquiry lacks the judicial authority of a trial court. It cannot determine the facts of a violent robbery based on the character assassination of a victim by the perpetrators themselves. 4. Ineffectiveness of Minor Preventive Legal Action While the police report references a Charge Sheet in Case No. 188/25 regarding an earlier dispute in September, it offers absolutely</p>

no remedy or legal protection for the severe crimes committed subsequently in October. The minor preventive action initiated under Section 126/135 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) has proven entirely ineffective. The offenders continue to occupy the premises through illegal means, running up financial liabilities under the complainant's name, and holding the stolen property with absolute impunity. 5. Open Defiance of the Directives of this Honorable Commission This Honorable Commission issued an explicit directive on 29/12/2025 ordering the Superintendent of Police, Mirzapur, to take appropriate legal action while strictly "associating the complainant" in the process. The resulting investigation report is a mere "paper exercise" drafted behind closed doors. The local inquiry officers completely excluded the complainant from the verification process, validated the offenders' version of events, and ignored the physical dispossession and humanitarian crisis forced upon the victim. 6. Manifestation of a Severe Humanitarian Crisis The local police executed these mechanical closures with total blindness to the victim's extreme vulnerabilities. At the time of the forced eviction on 24/10/2025, Smt. Archana Dubey was seven months pregnant, entering her third trimester under severe medical, financial, and psychological trauma. Furthermore, because of continuous death threats issued by the offenders and their close associate, Tinku Tiwari, the complainant's nine-year-old minor daughter has been forcibly pulled out of school. The refusal to register an FIR or provide interim security violates basic human rights guidelines. PRAYER In light of the facts recorded above, the complainant humbly prays that this Honorable Commission may be pleased to: 1-- REJECT the highly biased, incomplete, and legally flawed investigation report dated 18/02/2026 submitted by the Mirzapur Police. 2- DIRECT the Superintendent of Police, Mirzapur, to immediately recover and seize the central CCTV DVR from the possession of the offenders to prevent the permanent destruction of electronic evidence. 3- ORDER a fresh, independent investigation by a senior officer outside the local police hierarchy into the daylight robbery, house trespass, and forced dispossession that occurred on 24/10/2025. 4- ENSURE immediate administrative protection for the pregnant victim and her nine-year-old minor daughter against ongoing threats to their lives.
