Subject: Escalation regarding arbitrary and incomplete closure of Jansunwai Grievance No. 600002601173453 — unresolved civic hazards including improperly restored road, waterlogging, debris, and pending park beautification in Surekapuram Colony, Mirzapur

Respected Sir,

I wish to bring to your urgent notice the arbitrary closure of my grievance (Jansunwai Ref. No. 600002601173453, dated of action 04/08/2026) by the Executive Officer, Nagar Palika Parishad Mirzapur, and the continuing civic hazards that remain unresolved on ground despite this closure.

Point 1: The grievance was closed with the remark that debris had been removed from the referenced site. This is factually incomplete. While some clearance has occurred, photographic evidence confirms that debris piles and an improperly restored road surface remain present at the site, contradicting the closure claim.

Point 2: The road in question was dug up for laying a gas pipeline. Under standard municipal road-cutting norms, any agency disturbing a public road carries an obligatory duty to restore it to its original condition upon completion of work — this is a binding condition of permission, not a discretionary courtesy. The excavated pit has since been filled, but only with loose earth, without proper compaction, paving, or restoration of the original road surface. This does not constitute genuine restoration and leaves the road unsafe and uneven for pedestrians and vehicles. I request that the identity of the executing agency, the terms of the road-cutting permission granted to it, and the status of any restoration security deposit be disclosed, and that accountability be fixed if the obligatory restoration duty has not been properly discharged.

Point 3: During this construction, the connecting road at the junction of two residential rows was raised to a height of approximately 6 feet. As a direct result, water now stagnates at this junction

even during light rainfall, with the waterlogged stretch extending approximately 6 feet in length and covering the entire width of the road. I had personally requested, over telephone, that a temporary mori (drainage outlet) be installed to allow water to pass through. This request was completely disregarded, and the grievance was closed without any action being taken on it.

Point 4: A site inspection was conducted on 14/02/2023, and the department gave a written commitment that park beautification would be undertaken once 15th Finance Commission funds were released. While the related drainage repair (estimated at ₹77,303) has been completed, the primary beautification work for the Second Park in Surekapuram Colony has remained pending for over three years with no defined timeline.

Point 5: Piles of bricks and broken stone continue to remain on public land around the park, despite the closure remark stating otherwise, further obstructing the space meant for public use.

In view of the above, I respectfully request your urgent intervention to direct the concerned authorities to:

Point 1: Reopen Grievance No. 600002601173453, as the ground situation does not match the closure remarks.

Point 2: Ensure proper restoration of the road (compaction/paving as per original standard), and disclose accountability of the executing agency for the gas pipeline work, including the status of any restoration deposit.

Point 3: Immediately install a mori/temporary drainage outlet at the raised road junction to resolve the waterlogging problem.

Point 4: Ensure complete removal of remaining debris from the site.

Point 5: Fix a definite, time-bound schedule for the pending beautification of the Second Park, as per the department's own written commitment.

I am enclosing photographs of the site as supporting evidence for your kind perusal.

Subject Concerns regarding prolonged delay in the beautification of the Second Park road blockade and the safety hazards caused by stone cut pieces lying around the park in Mohalla Surekapuram Colony Mirzapur

Respected Sir

Through this formal grievance I wish to bring to your kind notice the sheer negligence and apathy of the administrative officials of the Nagar Palika Parishad Mirzapur. This matter directly pertains to the pending beautification of the neglected Second Park in Surekapuram Colony, the resolution of road blockages, and the severe civic difficulties being faced by the local residents due to dumped construction materials.

Firstly a detailed technical and site inspection was conducted more than three years ago on 14 February 2023 by the City Engineer and Junior Engineer of the Nagar Palika Parishad Mirzapur. Based on that inspection a formal cost estimate of 77303 rupees was prepared specifically for the drainage repair work. Furthermore the department explicitly committed in its written report that as soon as the funds under the 15th Finance Commission are released the beautification and development of the neglected Second Park will be executed immediately. While the drainage repair work has finally been fulfilled on the ground the primary work of developing and beautifying the park has been left entirely pending for years.

Secondly under the guise of infrastructure development the local administration has put the entire residential area into a state of severe distress. The current ground reality is that massive piles of interlocking bricks and broken stone cut pieces are lying scattered all around the park. These stone pieces and construction debris have been left completely abandoned on public land

for over a year. The debris has neither been organized nor removed transforming a community space into an unsightly dump yard.

Thirdly a deep and highly hazardous pit has been dug up right in the middle of the street for utility pipeline work. This pit has been left completely open and unsecured for the past one week. Due to this wide trench and the massive mounds of excavated earth and stones piled next to it the main thoroughfare has been entirely blocked. This road blockade has persisted continuously for a week making it nearly impossible for the residents to safely navigate the street or take out their vehicles.

Fourthly this prolonged road blockage and open trench pose a major safety hazard to local citizens especially young children and elderly residents. Due to the lack of proper street lighting at night this unsecured construction site is a major accident waiting to happen. While the Executive Officer and the local sanitation supervisor submit misleading closure reports on the portal claiming that regular cleaning and pesticide spraying are being conducted the actual physical state of the site severely undermines the credibility of the municipality updates.

Digital governance and the credibility of the Jansunwai portal rely entirely on ground execution rather than paperwork being prematurely closed by local officials. It is highly unfortunate that despite giving written assurances regarding the 15th Finance Commission fund allocation the municipality has delayed the park development indefinitely while forcing the public to live amidst blockades and heavy debris.

Therefore I urgently request your high office to intervene and direct D M Mirzapur

1 Immediate removal of all stone cut pieces and debris blocking the public space around the park

2 The immediate and safe closure of the deep pit dug on the road ensuring the thoroughfare is reopened for public movement without delay

3 The commencement and completion of development and beautification of the Second Park of Surekapuram Colony within a strict time frame using the previously designated 15th Finance Commission funds

Rating Remarks

The grievance has been only partially redressed and closure is factually incorrect. The Executive Officer's remark states debris has been removed, but photographic evidence confirms debris and the open, unsecured trench are still present on site, posing a safety hazard. More importantly, the core issue of Second Park beautification remains completely unaddressed. Despite a written departmental commitment (dated 14/02/2023) to develop the park once 15th Finance Commission funds are released, and completion of the related drainage repair work, no timeline or action has been taken for the park itself. Additionally, raised road construction has caused waterlogging (approx. 6 ft length, full road width) even in light rain. A verbal request for a temporary mori/drainage outlet was ignored. I request reopening of this case, immediate mori installation, complete debris/trench clearance, and a fixed timeline for park development.
